One or more of us have access to many sources of pertinent DX and general information, such as the Long Island DX Bulletin, The DX Bulletin, W6TI Bulletin, HR Reports, ARRL Bulletins, FCC Releases, Propagation Forecasts, Off the Air Info, etc. While a verbatim reading of this information would be extremely time consuming and probably boring, a synopsis of key items would be interesting. It would also make the net more than a check-in/check-out exercise. To quote our constitution, "It shall be our purpose to promote cooperation, exchange of information, improved operator proficiency, and fraternalism so as to advance Contest and DX activity within the amateur radio community." Bring what you can to the net. We will all benefit, and so will you.

During the past several months, we have seen rapid growth and expansion of the EIDXA. This welcome, and perhaps overdue, event means bigger and better things for our four-year-old club. As we have taken on new members, we have also taken on an obligation to service the new members, many of whom live outside the local Cedar Rapids area. This new newsletter goes a long way toward filling that need. Unfortunately, no bulletin or newsletter can provide real time DX information. That's where our informal DX alerting frequency, 147.57 MHz, comes in. Many a new country has been worked because somebody put the info on 2 meters. But what about the guys outside of the Cedar Rapids area? They can't hear many, or in some cases any, of the other members. While each of us having a respectable signal on 2 would do a lot to help the situation, I don't think that alone will solve the problem. Several years ago, we talked about a DX repeater to solve our Cedar Rapids/ Iowa City problem. After much discussion, we unanimously decided against it because we were, after all, DXers not VHFers. Is it time to reconsider? I don't have the answer. I am neither a proponent nor an opponent of a DX repeater. I simply want to point out that as we grow larger, there are new considerations to be addressed if we are to remain a successful DX and Contest organization.



As 8Z4A was finally logged several days after the JY's opened there DX-Pedition, I asked myself where and what is this place they call Saudi Neutral Zone?

Here is what I was able to find.... "As Saudi control spread outward from the center of the peninsula growth of the kingdom was limited in the north by international treaty and along its southern boundaries by self imposed limitation. The northern boundaries were established in the 1920s by a series of treaties negotiated between Abd al-aziz ibd Saud and British officials representing the intrests of Jordan, Iraq and Kuwait. These artificial boundaries have never been marked on the ground, and precise demarcations of the desert frontier remains uncertain. The treaties created two diamond shaped neutral zones, one on the Iraq border (824), and the other with Kuwait (9K3,8Z5), as a means of avoiding border conflicts. The neutral zone with Kuwait was partitioned in 1964-65 for the purpose of dividing the oil wealth in the area."

In December of 1969 9K3,825 was scratched from the DXCC list. As far as previous DX trips nothing other than a single mentioning of a QSL mgr back in a early 50°s QST, that pertains to 8Z4.




