The Eastern Iowa DX Association (EIDXA) was established in 1975 by a group of Cedar Rapids area amateurs interested in both DX and Contest work. The club was formed to enhance the DXCC totals of the membership, promote good DX operating practice, and encourage contest activity from Iowa. The EIDXA has grown from an original core of 12 people to a current membership of about 55 active amateurs.

Membership is by written application which must be approved by two thirds of the Full members. Membership is in two classes with general requirements as follows:

ASSOCIATE MEMBER

1. Interest in both DX and Contest work.
2. Valid Ham license and ARRL membership.
3. Payment of assessed dues.

FULL MEMBER

1. All Associate member requirements.
2. Possession of DXCC or equivalent.

Membership in the EIDXA must be maintained by payment of annual dues, attendance of two of the regular meetings each year, and participation in at least two contests per year with a score submitted for club aggregate scoring. In addition, Associate members must upgrade to Full membership within two years.

The EIDXA may also bestow Honorary membership on individual amateurs in recognition of special service to the EIDXA or the DX community. EI9V, 4Z4RU, and ZK1DR are the only EIDXA Honorary members. Inactive membership status is available to EIDXA members who move more than 150 miles from Cedar Rapids.

The EIDXA officers are President, Vice-President, and Secretary-Treasurer and are all Full members. They are elected for a one year term by vote of the Full members.

Formal meetings are held quarterly at a mutually agreed upon place, generally in the Cedar Rapids area. An EIDXA information net meets weekly on Wednesday evening at 9:30 local time on 2 meter FM, 144.590/145.190 MHz (W0MJN/rpt). In addition, an informal DX alerting service is available at all other times on this frequency.
