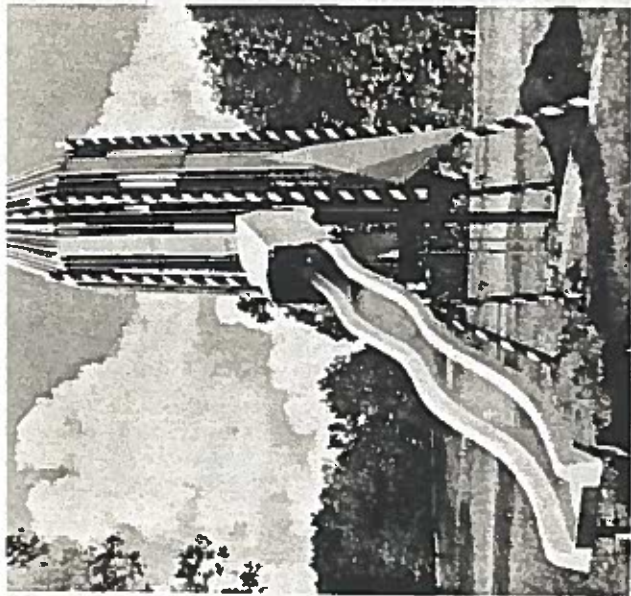

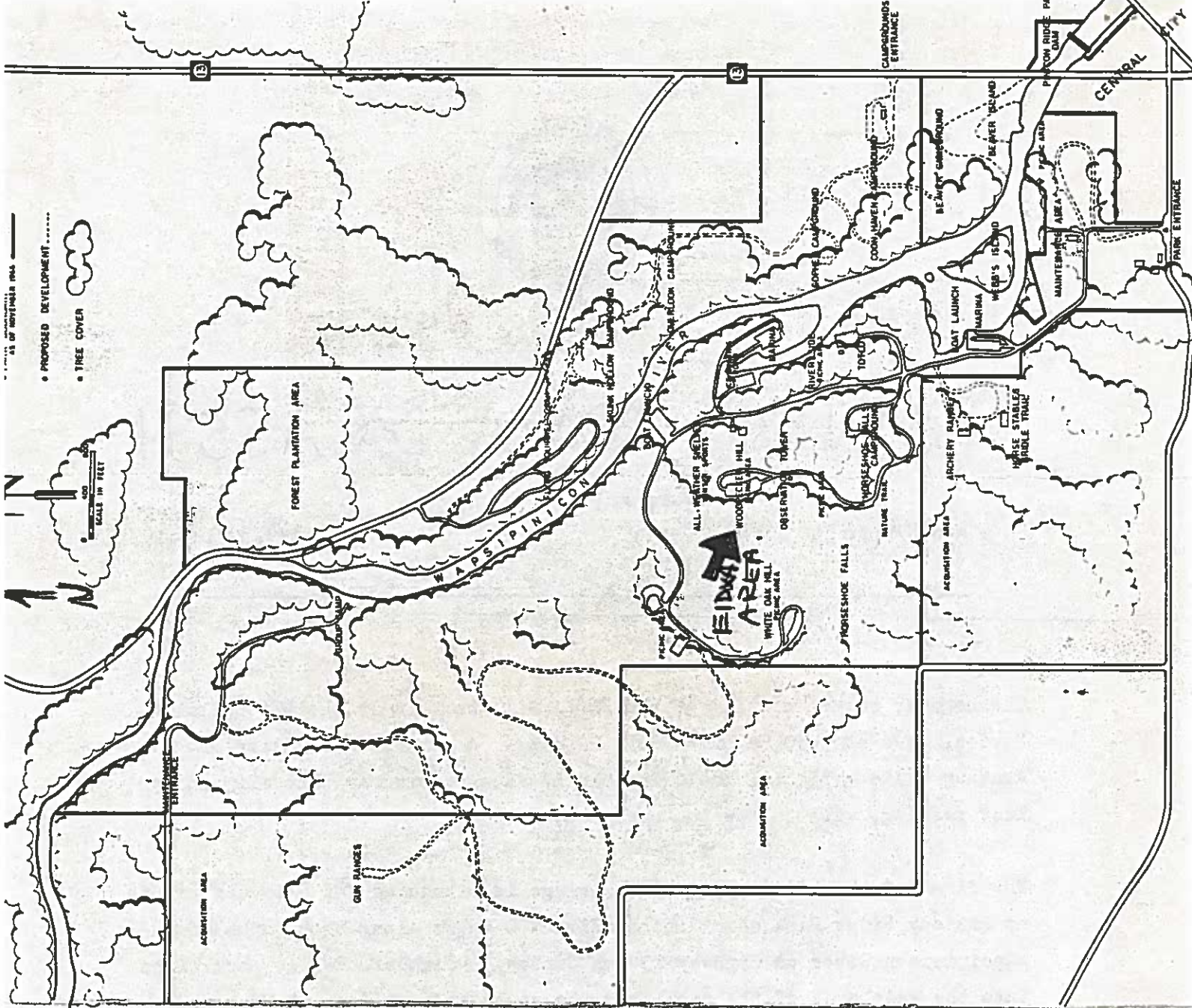
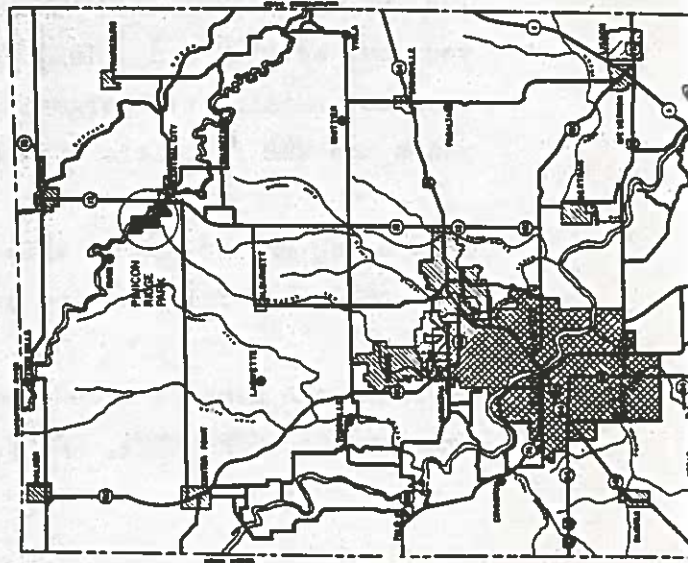

SATELLITES

OSCAR 8 Still sick-Battery problem-No operation.

RS birds Still Operational and the Russian birds providing the only Amateur Satellite Communication at the present time.

OSCAR 10 (Phase 3B) - Still not operational, but according to reports doing well. 1st Kick Motor firing was approximately 10 July and ran too long (190 vs planned 107 seconds) and gave the bird a higher perigee and a greater inclination angle with the equator than was planned. But according to the experts, this is not too bad. The angle is now at 25.7941° with apogee of 35490 KM & perigee of 3241 KM. Spacecraft spin is 26 RPM. The beacon (Mode B) can be heard on 145.810 Mhz 0000-0005 & 0030-0035 of each hour. Further details will be in August QST.

W5LFL has permission from NASA & FCC to operate from aboard the STS-9 mission scheduled to lift off around the end of September. All operation will be FM with tentative frequencies: Space to Earth - 145.510 to 145.770; Earth to Space- 144.910 to 145.470. Repeater inputs and outputs will be avoided.
